

## What to Bring (Packing List)

We recommend the following items to give your camper everything that he or she will need while away at camp. Of course, certain items (such as clothing) will vary depending on the length of your child's session and we leave that up to your discretion- **campers will not be able to do laundry during the session expect in the case of an emergency. Additionally, please label everything with camper's first and last names.** We suggest using a suitcase, duffel bag, plastic under-bed box or a trunk. Please keep in mind that luggage is kept under bunk beds.

### Clothing:

- T-Shirts
- Shorts
- A couple pairs of long pants/jeans
- Plenty of socks, thick ones for hiking
- Underwear
- Swimsuit(s)
- Sweatshirt/long sleeve shirt(s)
- Laundry Bag
- Rain jacket/poncho
- Pajamas
- Shower shoes/sandals if desired
- Sneakers for everyday use/sturdy shoes for hiking
- Camp appropriate footwear (must have a back)
- Bandanas

### Personal Care Items:

- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc.)
- Extra contact lenses and/or glasses
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Other personal items

### Additional Items for Specific Camps:

- Sleeping pad (St. George's IV, Explorers' Camps)
- Water shoes, such as Keens, Tevas or Chacos (St. George's IV, Explorers' Camps)

### Bedding and Linens:

- Twin sheets and/or
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow/pillowcase
- Bath towel(s)
- Pool towel(s)
- Washcloth/loofah
- Blanket

### Other Items:

- 2 Water bottles (**IMPORTANT**)
- Flashlight/batteries
- Sunglasses/hat
- Paper, pen, envelopes
- Stamps
- Camera (**not a smartphone**)
- Crazy creek (optional)
- Books/magazines
- Art supplies
- Bible and/or
- Book of Common Prayer

## What NOT to Bring

Please help us ensure that the following items are **NOT** brought to camp by reviewing what your child has packed before departing for camp. Please understand that if any of these items are found at camp, they will be confiscated immediately and your child may be sent home.

- **Electronic devices**
  - Mobile phones/phone watches/etc.
  - iPad, tablet, Kindle (except for reading purposes) or a laptop computer
  - Gaming devices, Video/DVD players
- **Any item that may be considered a weapon**
  - Knives, utility tools /multi-tool items such as a Swiss Army Knife
  - Firearms
  - matches, lighters, fireworks
- **Food** (snacks, candy, gum, drinks, etc.)
- **Tobacco products**
- **Alcohol or controlled substances**
- **Pets or other animals**
